

Millennial Kingdom

Essential: (fulfillment of promises to Israel and Christ).

Promised to David (2 Sam 7:12-17; 23:5) under oath (Ps 89:34-37).

Predicted in the Psalms and the Prophets (Ps 2; 45; 110; Isa 2:1-5; 4:1-6; 11:1-9; 12:1-6; 30:18-26; 35:1-10; 60, 61:3-62; 66; Jer 23:3-8; 32:37-44; Ezekiel 40-48; Dan 2:44-45; 7:13-14; 12:2-3; Mic 4:1-8; Zech 12:10-14:21).

**Promised to Mary (Lk 1:32; Mic 5:2; Isa 9:6, 7; Dan 2:44);
Reaffirmed to apostles (Lk 22:29-30).**

Lord's Prayer: "Thy Kingdom come"; "For thine is the kingdom (Mt 6:10, 13; Acts 1:6; Ps 45, 46, 47, 48).

Christ to Rule with a "Rod of Iron" (Psalm 2; 110; Rev 12:5; 19:15) as King of Kings, and Lord of Lords.

Every knee must bow to Christ Jesus (Phil 2:6-11). This is NOT a one time event!

Jesus "In the order of Melchizedek"—rules as King and Priest (Zech 6:12-13).

***Zec 6:12** Then speak to him, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying: "Behold, the Man whose name is the BRANCH! From His place He shall branch out, And He shall build the temple of the LORD;*

***Zec 6:13** Yes, He shall build the temple of the LORD. He shall bear the glory, And shall sit and rule on His throne; So He shall be a priest on His throne, And the counsel of peace shall be between them both.'"*

Worldwide worship will emanate from Millennial Temple (Ezek 43:7; 44:2; 46:1-3).

Ruler ship and blessing will come to Zion and from Zion (Isa 2:2-4; Jer 23:3-6; Mic 4:1-2).

Mic 4:1 *Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And peoples shall flow to it.*

Mic 4:2 *Many nations shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion the law shall go forth, And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.*

David will be king under Jesus (Ezek 37:24-25; 34:23-24; Jer 30:9; Hos 3:5).

Eze 37:24 *"David My servant shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd; they shall also walk in My judgments and observe My statutes, and do them.*

Eze 37:25 *Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, their children, and their children's children, forever; and My servant David shall be their prince forever.*

Hos 3:4 *For the children of Israel shall abide many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred pillar, without ephod or teraphim.*

Hos 3:5 *Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the LORD their God and David their king. They shall fear the LORD and His goodness in the latter days.*

The entire creation will be changed (Isa 35:1-10, Zech 14:8-10, Ez 47:1-12);

Isa 35:1 *The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, And the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose;*

Isa 35:2 *It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, The excellency of our God.*

Isa 35:3 *Strengthen the weak hands, And make firm the feeble knees.*

Isa 35:4 *Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you."*

Isa 35:5 *Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.*

Isa 35:6 *Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert.*

Isa 35:7 *The parched ground shall become a pool, And the thirsty land springs of water; In the habitation of jackals, where each lay, There shall be grass with reeds*

and rushes.

Isa 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.

Isa 35:9 No lion shall be there, Nor shall any ravenous beast go up on it; It shall not be found there. But the redeemed shall walk there,

Isa 35:10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Curse partially lifted (Isa 11:1-9);

Isa 11:1 There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.

Isa 11:2 The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Isa 11:3 His delight is in the fear of the LORD, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;

Isa 11:4 But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

Isa 11:5 Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins, And faithfulness the belt of His waist.

Isa 11:6 "The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, The leopard shall lie down with the young goat, The calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little child shall lead them.

Isa 11:7 The cow and the bear shall graze; Their young ones shall lie down together; And the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

Isa 11:8 The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den.

Isa 11:9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD As the waters cover the sea.

Creation partially redeemed- returned to a Eden like condition (Gen 3, Rom 8:20-22);

Rom 8:20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope;

Rom 8:21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Rom 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.

Land promise to Abraham fulfilled; each to have "own land" (Micah 4:4; Amos 9:15; Ez 47:13-23)

Deu 32:6 *Do you thus deal with the LORD, O foolish and unwise people? Is He not your Father, who bought you? Has He not made you and established you?*

Deu 32:7 *"Remember the days of old, Consider the years of many generations. Ask your father, and he will show you; Your elders, and they will tell you:*

Deu 32:8 *When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, When He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the children of Israel.*

Deut 32:9 *For the LORD's portion is His people; Jacob is the place of His inheritance.*

Jos 18:10 *Then Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh before the LORD, and there Joshua divided the land to the children of Israel according to their divisions.*

Fruitful and prosperous (Amos 9:13-15)

Amo 9:13 *"Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, And all the hills shall flow with it.*

Amo 9:14 *I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them.*

Amo 9:15 *I will plant them in their land, And no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given them," Says the LORD your God.*

It will be a time of peace

Isa 2:1 *The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.*

Isa 2:2 *Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it.*

Isa 2:3 *Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.*

Isa 2:4 *He shall judge between the nations, And rebuke many people; They shall beat their swords into plowshares, And their spears into pruning hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, Neither shall they learn war anymore.*

It will be a Theocracy- a religious society ruled by God, for God with a temple dedicated to Him, and Him alone (Amos 9:11; Ez 43,44,46)

- Eze 43:1** Afterward he brought me to the gate, the gate that faces toward the east.
- Eze 43:2** And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. His voice was like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory.
- Eze 43:3** It was like the appearance of the vision which I saw—like the vision which I saw when I came to destroy the city. The visions were like the vision which I saw by the River Chebar; and I fell on my face.
- Eze 43:4** And the glory of the LORD came into the temple by way of the gate which faces toward the east.
- Eze 43:5** The Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the temple.
- Eze 43:6** Then I heard Him speaking to me from the temple, while a man stood beside me.
- Eze 43:7** And He said to me, "Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever. No more shall the house of Israel defile My holy name, they nor their kings, by their harlotry or with the carcasses of their kings on their high places.

It will be Israeli centric (Zech 14:16-21; Is 2:2)

- Zec 14:16** And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
- Zec 14:17** And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain.
- Zec 14:18** If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
- Zec 14:19** This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
- Zec 14:20** In that day "HOLINESS TO THE LORD" shall be engraved on the bells of the horses. The pots in the LORD's house shall be like the bowls before the altar.
- Zec 14:21** Yes, every pot in Jerusalem and Judah shall be holiness to the LORD of hosts. Everyone who sacrifices shall come and take them and cook in them. In that day there shall no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts
- Isa 2:2** Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it.

Earth full of knowledge of the Lord (Isa 11:9; Hab 2:14).

- Isa 11:9** They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD As the waters cover the sea.

It is NOT eternity: there will still be Death, and sin (Isa

65:20);

Isa 65:19 *I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.*

Isa 65:20 *"No more shall an infant from there live but a few days, Nor an old man who has not fulfilled his days; For the child shall die one hundred years old, But the sinner being one hundred years old shall be accursed.*

Isa 65:21 *They shall build houses and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit.*

Isa 65:22 *They shall not build and another inhabit; They shall not plant and another eat; For as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people, And My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.*

Isa 65:23 *They shall not labor in vain, Nor bring forth children for trouble; For they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the LORD, And their offspring with them.*

Isa 65:24 *"It shall come to pass That before they call, I will answer; And while they are still speaking, I will hear.*

Isa 65:25 *The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, The lion shall eat straw like the ox, And dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain," Says the LORD.*

Has a very specific duration (Rev 20:2,3,4,5,6,7)

Now, let's take a breath, relax, and put it all together:

In this age here is our condition:

Eph 6:12 ***For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.***
